We fully appreciate that occasionally you may be unexpectedly and/or unavoidably delayed slightly to pick up your child/ren. In these instances, we appreciate a phone call to let us know that you are running a few minutes late. However, some pupils are routinely collected late at the end of their school day and this impacts staff who often need to attend meetings, run clubs or carry out jobs and tasks in preparation for the next school day. Support staff, who often stay behind in these instances, are not paid after 3.30pm. We would be grateful if you could ensure that you pick your child/ren up on time to enable staff to carry on their work promptly after school or, in the case of support staff, leave work on time.

Please could I also remind you that we do expect a phone call (as Class Dojo messages are not always checked during the day) to inform us of any change of routine to picking up your child/ren. If we are not sure whether a pupil is meant to be collected by someone at the end of the day, we will, for safeguarding purposes, need to check with you which will delay them being released.
