Welsh Week/Wythnos Cymraeg

We will be holding our annual St. David's Day celebrations in school throughout the week beginning Monday 3rd March. Each day of the week, pupils are encouraged to wear any type of Welsh clothing/costume or to come to school wearing the colours of the Welsh flag.

Parents are invited into school at 9.30am on Tuesday 4th March for a short assembly where each class will perform. This will be a chance for us to acknowledge and recognise our Welsh heritage and history with parents during this special national celebration.

We will also be holding elements of our annual school Eisteddfod throughout the week and we invite all pupils to take part in some way. During our Welsh Week, pupils will prepare for the recitation element and produce some poetry/written work. However, there will be several other activities for pupils to join in with and although entry is optional, it is hoped that each pupil will become involved in at least one.

At home, pupils are encouraged to practise/attempt as many of the following activities that they are comfortable with. Entries for art/craft, cooking and photography should be brought to school on Monday 3rd March.

Art/Craft

Create a piece of art or craft that reflects what it means to be Welsh or includes Welsh icons/items.

Dance

Individuals or groups are invited to present any type of dance to any song written or performed by a Welsh artist e.g.

Tom Jones, Duffy, Stereophonics, etc.

Singing

Individuals or groups are invited to sing any song written or performed by a Welsh artist e.g. Tom Jones, Duffy, Stereophonics, etc. This should be performed to a backing track and with no backing lyrics.

Cookerv

Children to cook/create their own Welsh dish.

Photography

Children to submit any kind of photography based on our county, Pembrokeshire.

These will be judged throughout the week and first, second and third prizes will be presented for each category. Please ensure that any entries that are submitted for judging are labelled with your child's name, age and class. We hope that we will have many entries for what promises to be a very enjoyable and exciting week of celebration for us all.
