UNIFORM POLICY

Introduction

As per Welsh Government Policy on School Uniform, the Governors of Sageston CP School, strongly encourage all children to wear school uniform and request that parents maintain a good standard of cleanliness.

The benefits of wearing uniform have been clearly identified in terms of better discipline, pride taken in school and a greater sense of identity, belonging and community within the school.

There is also less competition between children in terms of what they wear to school, and there are no disagreements between parents and children about what a child should wear to school.

Parents are asked to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with their child's name to help to identify lost property.

Purchasing the Sageston School uniform

The above items can be purchased locally from Tees R Us in New Hedges, Tenby, or online from myclothing.com at very competitive prices. In addition to uniform other items are also available e.g. reading bags etc. All these items have the school logo embroidered onto them. However, there is no expectation that parents and carers purchase school uniform from these outlets or that school uniform must have the school logo embroidered into it. Parents are asked to ensure that uniform does conform to main colour of the uniform identified above.

PE kits

For PE lessons pupils are required to have a P.E. bag containing shorts, t-shirt and trainers, and for swimming a bathing costume, swimming hat and towel.

The school prospectus contains further information about the PE kit required. This is presented to all parents on entering the school.

Additional Information

Footwear – We request that appropriate footwear is worn at all times. High-heeled shoes, sandals, flip flops etc. can be a safety hazard and, therefore, are discouraged. Sensible shoes are the preferred option to be worn.

Jewellery - If earrings must be worn to school, they must be restricted to small 'stud' or 'sleeper' type. These should be removed before P.E. and Games as there have been some nasty accidents documented where children have suffered torn ear lobes. All other jewellery is discouraged in the interests of safety and to avoid problems if an item is lost.

Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be fairly simple and if possible in school colours.

The Governors and staff hope that parents choosing to send their children to Sageston CP School will support the 'ethos' of the school by sending their children in agreed school dress.
